Short Essay Assignment

You are required to write two short critical essays on two of the three sections of the course. Here are some guidelines for the essays.

1. Each essay should be 5 pages long, double-spaced and in 11 or 12 point font.
2. Your essay should draw upon at least **five** sources from your chosen section.
3. If you are concerned about your grade, you may write three essays. I will evaluate all three and count the best two out of three for your grade.
4. Your grade will be broken down in the following way:
Content: $\frac{3}{4}$ of your grade is based on the content of your essay. Content includes what you say and how you clearly explain it and support it with evidence from the texts and our discussions in class.
Style and following directions: The other $\frac{1}{4}$ of your grade is based on clarity of writing, proper use of grammar, proper spelling and proofreading. It is also based on following directions with proper page length, font, and use of at least 5 sources.
5. For each section, you can write about the larger theme (such as, rebels) or one of the sub-themes (such as, rebels who claimed their own humanity). You can write about a topic that we discussed during your chosen topic (such as, how effective are militant strategies? How did the NWP use them successfully)? Or, you can write about a topic of your own choosing that is related to the texts for your chosen section. Please feel free to talk with me (either through email or at my office hours) about possible paper topics.
